



ABSTRACT

The visual arts creation thesis entitled Emotion In Line 1) To study "emotions" in nature, trees and branches pass through the lines to reflect the emotions that are assimilated into the feelings of "emotion" of the line. 2) To create the visual arts: Painting Mixed Media on canvas is created by combining techniques of the visual arts, such as drawing, acrylic colours, alcohol ink, correction fluid, and clay, to create works of art. Focusing on the principles of art composition inspired by nature. Explore the emotional expression in black, white, and grey pictures, express personal emotions through colours and lines, and resonate with the overall feeling. Arouse the most authentic emotions and find inner peace inspired by the beautiful scenery of mountains, trees, rivers, seas, and other natural landscapes. This study aimed to explore the nature of emotions and how they relate to lines in nature. Natural studies can be complemented with data on the lives and feelings of urban people in order to better understand the relationship between nature and emotional well-being. This creative work was conducted with the data collected from the conditions of the environment, the data from related documents, and the data about the creation of influential visual arts. The researcher analyzed the data to find the clarity of the theme, symbolic form, and creation techniques.

Conceptual of Frame Work

Taking the "emotions" in nature and life as the main line, collect image resources: photos of travel scenery, pictures of daily life activities, and images from the Internet. Extract the "emotional" characteristics of the tree, and combine them with life feelings to dig and understand them deeply, and express my intuition and perception through visual elements and aesthetic thinking.

more clearly.




Figure 1 Chongqing Zhaomu Mountain Forest Park 1 Photo by Wang Yu , Date Nov 15 , 2021




Figure 4 Mahasarakham 1




Figure 15 Chongqing3

(Wen sees the world, 2020: Online) At present, the richness of urban life and the convenience of satisfying their needs are making people living in cities gradually become psychologically numb. According to psychological research, those who are unaware of the joyful experience of daily life events occurring in themselves, the more rich, the more insecure about what they have. This lack of security can lead them to take even crazier behavior to experience the phenomenal abundance of life and then lead to a more empty heart. The inner sense of inner emptiness gradually

occupies the main position of psychological activities in life, evolving into a kind of life state in which urbanites often experience "anxiety, depression, fear, and compulsion" emotions. (Huang Xinjing, 2020: Online)

The experience itself (especially the so-called "traumatic experience") does not hurt us, but we will extract something that suits our purpose and explain it. We give meaning to our past experiences, and then we decide what we want to be. We may always make some mistakes when we base our future lives on a certain past experience. Because the environment doesn't determine the meaning of things, but the meaning we give it to the environment can determine who we are. (The Paper news, 2022: Online)

According to Stanley-Shaht, the experience of emotions is the product of a combination of physiological arousal and cognitive evaluation, which are essential for the occurrence of emotions. All arousal is assumed to be universal, undifferentiated, and arousal is the first step in the emotional sequence. Individuals first evaluate physiological arousal to determine what they feel, which emotional labels are the most compatible, and what your response means in the pending context of the emotional experience. That is, the emotional experience cannot be simply

understood as what happens in the individual or in the brain, but the interaction is considered and evaluated by the former with the environment. The theory also emphasizes that evaluation usually occurs in the unconscious state. When you have past experiences related to the context of the emotional generation, you don't have to deliberately explain your arousal environmentally. This claim is defined as a theory of cognitive evaluation of emotion. Cognitive evaluation is important, but not the only emotional experience process, and it may be safest to make such conclusions. In some cases, you will actually consider the impact of the situation (at least unconsciously) to explain why it feels so. In others, however, your emotional experience may be controlled by evolved innate mechanisms. The physiological response does not require any explanation. These different ways of emotional experience show that emotions often affect your eyes. (Duoduo Women's net, 2021: Online)

Theory

The study of concepts and theories related to research, such as beauty, aesthetics, and visual elements, Chinese ink for creative drawing, The relevant psychology is described as follows.

Water ink painting is painted by water and ink in different deep ink colors, is a form of painting, more often, water ink is considered a representative of traditional Chinese paintings, that is, national paintings. Also known as national painting and Chinese painting. Water ink is one of the traditional paintings of China. (Baidubaike, 2023: Online)

Emotion: In psychology, emotion is defined as: emotion is the psychological phenomenon of the relationship between the individual and the environmental meaning of time. (Jiang Wei, 2018)

Expressionism, refers to the art to emphasize the subjective feelings and feelings of the artist, and leads to the exaggeration, deformation and even bizarre treatment of objective forms, a thinking trend that uses to leak out inner grief, believes that the subject is the only real, denies the objectivity of the real world, opposes the purposes of art, it is especially popular in the field of painting in the early 20th century in the Nordic countries, is a reflection of social cultural crisis and spiritual chaos, in the social turmoil representation is especially prominent and strong. (Baidu Baike, 2023: Online)

Aesthetics: By Alexander Gotitliek Baumgarten believes that the object of aesthetics is to study beauty, that is, to study the perfection of sensory awareness. He said: "The object of aesthetics is the perfection of sensory cognition (on its own), which is beauty; on the contrary, it is the imperfection of the perception of sensation, which is ugly. "Beauty, teaching how to think in a beautiful way, is the task of the science of studying the low-level ways of understanding, that is, as the aesthetics of the lower-level theory of understanding. That is to say, as a low-level cognitive aesthetics, its task is to study the perfection of senses and knowledge, that is, beauty.

By Georg Wilhelm Friedrich Hegel argued that the object of aesthetics is the art of studying beauty. He said: "The object of aesthetics is the vast field of beauty, more precisely, its scope is art, or rather, the art

of beauty."What he says is not real beauty, but artistic beauty.He believes that the legitimate name of aesthetics is "art philosophy", or more precisely, "the philosophies of fine art."According to the name of aesthetics as "the philosophy of the art of beauty", the beauty of nature is excluded from the field of the esthetic study.But Hegel also studied natural beauty, which he studied because natural beauty is a reflection of the beauty of the mind, that is, art.(Baidubaike, 2023: Online)

Elements of art refers its main elements often include form, shape, line, color, value, space, texture, and insight. This elements can also be simplified into lines, shapes, textures, colors etc. Art will use this knowledge to explain.

The German artist Paul Klee once said, "Walk with a line," that the essence of the line lies in its emotional meaning, that is, expresses the fine feelings and subtle emotions of the painter, but also expresses rich lines to leave us unlimited space for imagination. (Tan Daoyi, Hao Zhengang, 2011)

Visual "beauty" points originate from the understanding of the law of form beauty (the human experience summary and abstract summary of the laws of form of beauty in the process of creation of beauty), which can refer to the visual work that causes people to feel visual beauty and obtain aesthetic pleasure. (Sohu, 2018: Online)

Different lines correspond to different patterns of force in different emotions. For example, all the horizontal line, the center line is always with stability, stability, consistency, unity phase echo. All vertical lines

and broken lines are always similar to excitement, rage, tough, strong and other emotional force style. All curve and turning more gentle line, often always consistent with gentle, quiet, leisurely, joy, the direction up or forward line, often corresponding to aggressive, active, thoughts and emotions, and the direction down, or backward line, always corresponding to weak, lax, depressed, lack of vitality and other thoughts and emotions.(Yang Dangxun, 2012: Online)

The psychology of colour influences the human mind, so there is a sense of seeing colour, and colour has a sensory meaning, such as black. It has a strong meaning: sadness, mystery, emptiness; grey, giving meaning to sadness, silence, calmness, sadness; white, purity, brightness, cheerfulness. (lilbang, 1993)

Color is the first visual language, and when humans first come into contact with a thing to make a first impression, color attractiveness is often higher than the impression generated by its shape. black transmission: deep, dark; white transfer: simple, pure, clean, refreshing; grey transfer: neutral, cool.(Cdc.tencent, 2013: Online)

In the graphic shape, the line is d fictitiousmore emotional in color, which is mainly reflected in length, thickness, curve anness.Lines can generally be divided into two categories of straight lines and curves.Direct lines can be divided into erect lines, horizontal lines, sloping lines, curved lines, radiation lines and so on.Curves can be divided into S curves, arc lines, and spiral lines.The vertical line gives people the feeling of "falling down, rising up, stable, strong. The horizontal line gives people the feeling of "stability, smoothness,"

quietness, rationality, orderly. The sloping line gives people the feeling of "living, tilt, movement, momentum, strength, stimulation, danger.

The curved line gives people the feeling of "tension, strength, guidance, conflict. The sensation of radiation is accentuation, concentration, highlight, speed, launch, force, direction, impact. The Stype curve gives people the feeling of being soft, feminine, inclusive, growing, comfortable, pleasant, safe. The arc gives people the feeling of elasticity, abundance, tension, vitality, elegance, strength, law. The spiral line gives people the feeling of mystery, rhythm, dizziness. The freedom curve gives people the feeling of freedom, romance, sprinkling. The hidden line of view gives people the feeling of hope, vitality, inclusion. (Uisdc, 2018: Online)

In his opinion, black represents death and darkness, while white represents life and light. Although the formed picture structure seems to be messy, it is actually a philosophical thinking through comparison. He uses the contrast of two polar colors, black and white, to explore the philosophical essence of life and death. (Zhi Hu, 2019: Online)

The calm and rational emotions transmitted by the three colorless colors themselves also meet the psychological needs of modern people. The combination of black and white refers to something more essential under the color. (Souhu, 2022: Online)

From this point of view, this simple expression method, with a strong romantic colour and lyricism and black and white consciousness, is a creative awareness. The creative principle is to reduce the quantity,

white and black art to colourless, in the most concise language, to express the rich content. It is the author according to his art cultivation, the result of natural observation, understanding, exploration, as well as the synthesis of natural expression, thought emotions and thinking, etc. The artist through the setup, distribution, order, combination of nature, to make the expression objects have a visual pleasure and beauty. (Hu Lianjiang, 2011)

Influence from Visual Arts

Influenced by expressionism, he emphasizes the artist's subjective feelings and self-feeling, expressing emotions with twists and lines. From different line performances and density structures to reflect different lightness surfaces, and to interpret the infinitely rich colors with changes in black and white, the pictures are extremely concise but not monotonous. Shows the influence of foreign artists such as Edward Munch (Norway), Vincent Willem van Gogh. (Netherlands), Kathe Kollwitz (Germany). Graham Yarrington (USA).

1. Edward Munch has depicted death the most in his life. We can see this clearly from his works "Adolescence", "Sick Child" and "At the Bedside of the Dead". His artistic creation is completely close to his personal experience in writing, followed by the creation of the representative work "Scream" with very personal artistic characteristics. The creation of this work was inspired by the fact that after the

protagonist and his friends got together and separated, he walked alone on the bridge, and he said that he "heard the hustle and bustle of nature".

Due to the influence of family factors from childhood to adolescence, his personal melancholy and pessimistic temperament infected him, causing the artist to fall into a kind of endless loneliness and fear, and the spirit screamed wildly. Some people say that there is a psychiatric hospital and a slaughterhouse under that bridge, and there will be a steady stream of screams coming out, just like what is said in traditional Chinese thinking, the more extreme the opposite, the more noisy a place is, the more lonely people feel. The crazy deformed characters, distorted lines, and shocking colors in the picture are the author's most real feelings at that time. The irresistible sense of loneliness, the rushing colors when the heart is restless, and the tedious lines when the heart is flustered, when these three come together, it is the author's inner cry. It is precisely because we have the same experience as the author that we can have the same resonance when we see such a painting that is completely separated from the "objective" subject. This kind of experience is the real world, which we deeply understand The common ground, the artist found this point and ignited it.

The authenticity of art lies in the authenticity of its inner impulse. The expression and emotion of this painting have brought me a lot of inspiration. This is the artist's concern for people, let us feel the innermost feelings The "true me".

Since the color is reflected in the lightness direction, when various lines are used to express the lightness and darkness of the object, it also expresses different color senses, which is also an important way of expression in my works.






Figure 28 Artist : Kathe Kollwitz

Collection and Analysis Data

1. Data Collection

Through the methods of reading books and document retrieval, I have a deeper understanding of the different doctrines of the painting school and browse a large number of works of domestic and foreign artists, and make selections based on themes, sources of inspiration, and different emotional expressions.

The author went to many places to collect scenes. The trees are the main visual scenery. Trees of different shapes and angles give people different emotions. And carry out the extraction experiment on the image of trees, and express it in a variety of painting forms. Through the Internet, theoretical research has been carried out on the theory of expressionism, the emotional expression of lines, and the point, line, and surface of Kandinsky's abstract art.

2. Data Analysis

2.1 Analysis of theme

These days, life moves us forward. The former mountains, rivers and fields have become straight high-rise buildings, and the lines of the city have also changed the development of society. People no longer live in slow motion like they did in the 1970s and 1980s. The pace of life is getting faster and faster, and today's society is getting more and more anxious. Many people are tirelessly, endlessly busy, frustrated, and yearn for a peaceful and comfortable life. This article revolves around the source of inspiration of "emotion", extracts the lines and shapes of nature, and combines them with life experience to dig and comprehend them deeply.

2.2 Analysis of form symbols

The growth of plants first grows upwards, then radially expands outwards, and finally shrinks downwards, showing the whole life from beginning to end. Plants The main growth movement is to spiral up or expand radially around a central axis.

Lines are the product of abstract thinking combined with visual thinking; they are a carrier of the artist's true feelings, abstracting

and sublimating a complicated world, interpreting the infinitely rich colors with black and white changes, making the picture Simple but not monotonous. In the process of a large number of choices, the picture is extremely strengthened, which is also the extreme strengthening of the artist's emotion. The premise of strengthening is the courage to give up.

2.3 Analysis of techniques

The work uses acrylic paints in black, white and gray to give full play to subjective initiative, and uses the basic rules of contrast between objects to simplify and refine lines. Created in the form of handpainting, the picture uses a large number of distorted lines to reflect the author's emotional changes and consciousness expression. The thick white color of the correction fluid and the uniform lines extruded make the picture have a certain order.

The background uses Chinese ink and wash, the light ink and light color make the picture have a sense of breathing, and the transparent light black gives people a natural, elegant and harmonious feeling.

Process of Creation

1. Sketches/ Model

From collected material images to art, sketching is a necessary process. Look for trees of different shapes, social moods, and draw with the monochromatic lines of a pencil. Different ideas, analysis of images on the subject, forming content and constructing layouts. Through the inherent morphological changes such as the length, thickness, thickness,

and density of the lines, as well as the dynamic changes in the size, curvature, and fluency of the lines, the personal emotional consciousness is fully expressed in the picture. When the emotions are unified with the picture, draw on the frame again with pencil, acrylic paint, ink, etc.




Figure 33 Correction fluid




Figure 40 Work in step 5




Figure 52 Thesis work 5




Figure 57 Thesis work 10
