






These shapes may no longer strictly follow the original two-dimensional oracle bone calligraphy, but be adjusted and innovated according to the author's creative intention and the overall design of the sculpture.

Three-dimensional structure. Based on the combination of ancient characters and modern Chinese characters, the visual forms of different periods can be seen from different angles to increase the layering of the sculpture. can be adjusted to be smooth or rough and rough. Moreover, the plaster is lightweight. Easy to move and durable Can be preserved for a long time.





Figure 1 Conceptual of Frame Work




Figure 5 Xiang xing

2.1 "Xiangxing" is a method of creating characters that are drawn to imitate the shape of things, such as "月" written to resemble a curved moon shape.




Figure 6 Zhi shi




Figure 7 Hui Yi

stories or shapes that are used for other purposes. That is, it will provide direct value to the viewer with its pure form and that form will express emotion, wisdom, or beauty by itself. Shape therefore means a structure that has order, beauty, and meaning, made up of visual elements, including lines, weight, space, color, and texture. Chalood Nimsamer, (2014)

and said that visual arts, which include painting, sculpture, printmaking, mixed media art and possibly architecture, are There are important components: shape and content. Forms are the concrete parts of materials and visual elements that are touched by the visual nerve. Content is the abstract part. that can be felt through the senses through shapes such as stories, emotions, and symbols. Chalood Nimsamer, (1989)

Influence from Visual Arts

Eduardo Chillida is one of the most important Spanish sculptors of the twentieth century¹. During his fifty-year career, he produced extraordinary works that established him as one of Spain's most distinctive and internationally renowned artists. Through his exploration of form, material and space, he continues to innovate and challenge the tradition of sculpture, and is recognized by the audience¹. His cutting-edge and diverse practice includes small sculptures, plaster works, paintings, carvings and collages, most notably his public sculptures that have been exhibited throughout Europe and the United States¹. Preferring to use elemental forms, the iron sculptures used are characterized by the contrast between the solidity of the iron and the openness of the design. Later granite works are also marked by contrasting relationships, particularly the architectural relationships of large stones. Unlike most modern sculpture, his works are the product of direct contact with the material, either by forging metal or carving stone. Coming from a long tradition of Spanish metalworkers and stone carvers, he preserves the craftsman's feel for the material.




Figure 9 The Wind Comb






Figure 13 (甲骨文) Oracle Bone Inscriptions




Figure 14 (金文) Bronze characters




Figure 16 (楷书) Kaisu character




Figure 18 (草书) Cao Su Character

2. The character "田" (tián) means rice field, representing soil, water and fertility.

Character "田" (tián): The shape is similar to a square, symbolizing stability, order and balance.

2.3 Analysis of techniques

A variety of techniques are used to create sculptures based on Chinese characters. These techniques help artists create meaningful, expressive works.

Material selection The choice of material of a text sculpture is critical to the final artistic effect. Commonly used materials include steel, wood, cloth, etc. Artists need to choose the right materials based on the sculpture's content, size, and intended effect. For example, wrought iron can convey the raw beauty of metal. While plaster can offer a sophisticated and modern feel. Symbol processing The essence of an oracle bone sculpture is to express a message in the form of a sculpture. Therefore, an in-depth study of the oracle bone glyphs is required. Understand structure, proportion and rhythm and then masterfully incorporate these into the sculpture. surface treatment The surface treatment of the oracle bone sculpture is also important. Artists can improve the surface of their sculptures through grinding, polishing, polishing, and other techniques. To be more consistent with the theme and style.

The technical analysis of text sculpture involves many aspects such as material selection, carving techniques, glyph processing, material application and surface treatment. It is necessary to use these technical methods comprehensively to create works with unique artistic charm and cultural connotation.

This work mainly expresses the cultural power of the Chinese nation. And ancient cultures recorded symbols of the power of farming. The work expresses itself through the properties of plaster. Most of the works are a combination of ancient and modern texts. and see the language and texts of various eras from different angles The work evokes a sense of both ancient and modern cultural power expressed through modern sculptural techniques.

The materials and equipment used in the production process include wire, iron pliers, plaster, files, gloves and other materials. Iron wire is widely used in the construction field and is a convenient and quick shape-shaping material. Gypsum is a widely used industrial and construction material. It can be used as cement retarder, gypsum building products, and model making. A file is a grinding tool that can smooth a rough surface to a perfect finish.

3. Visual Arts Experimentation

Experimenting with creative methods means that the author has a creative experimentation process through many experiments. Because many techniques and

methods have only recently had the opportunity to learn. such as molding and casting with plaster steel welding Using gypsum to create work


Figure 21 Small prototypes of works made from plaster

Curving up on both sides were a pair of horns. and the two lines extending diagonally up under the horns were a pair of ears of the bull. Cows are sacred in the hearts of ancient Chinese people. At the end of the year, ancient people would hold grand events to pay more respect to their ancestors and gods. Cows are generally used in large sacrificial ceremonies. Cows are the most sacred animals in the hearts of ancient people, very important. During the agricultural period Cattle are the main labor force. They were often used for farming and pulling carts. They are essential to human life and production. It also represents wealth. With the progress of the industrial era Machines have gradually replaced cattle. And the morphological characteristics of cattle play an important role in social life.

1.2 Form: The work is first scaled using a sketch to determine the angles of each stroke direction. Then use the prepared material to fix it. The material is wood board mixed with gypsum. The board has high density and easily absorbs the gypsum material on the surface. The gypsum surface can be easily polished after drying. The slanted design of the "cow" oracle bone inscription represents the gradual decline. The

fading of ancient letters and the modern letters that support them today. at the same time You can see the characters in different time periods from different angles Create unique personalities and visual effects that incorporate modern visual art reproduction

1.3 Meaning: Ox has the meaning of prosperous career in traditional Chinese culture. It indicates that your career will take off and develop in the future, you will encounter fewer obstacles at work, your career status will soar, and you will eventually become a successful leader.




Figure 23 Sketch 1






Figure 26 Thesis work 1.1




Figure 27 Thesis work 1.2

2.Thesis work 2

2.1 Idea/ Concept: In the oracle bone inscription, the character "inside the house" is a glyph that resembles a house with a thatched roof. It indicates that it is a family. Therefore, the meaning of the word "household" gradually expanded to mean a harmonious and happy family. In Chinese culture, "home" is a very important concept. It represents family, love and friendship. Family resonates with everyone. The main strength of the house is to create a happy and welcoming harbor. Everyone desires beauty. In terms of destination Men are a

strong shield that protects their families. and their arms holding their children represents the future.

2.2 Form: The letters are either upside down or sideways.⁷ The shape of the work comes after being unique to the Turtle Kradok letter. The author finds it interesting There fore used to design the work From the first work, the problem appeared to be defective and easily broken. For the second piece New materials are being tried. Steel is welded to hold the model's frame. and use foam to repair the shape After separating the fiberglass and foam So the pouring began. in the last step Let the plaster dry and polish the surface. The oracle's bone inscriptions blend with modern writing. First, the outer outline is an extension of the arm of the male owner leading a child. The shape of the arms is typical of a house in ancient script. The family eaves in modern writing convey happy people living under the house. There are three of them and the male protagonist is able to protect his family from the wind and rain.

2.3 Meaning: It means that there will be no disasters. Oxen themselves are loyal and honest animals. They can calm down disasters at home, improve personal good luck, and reduce unexpected changes and obstacles that may occur in life. They are very helpful for improving future fortune.




Figure 30 Sketch 2




Figure 37 Thesis work 2.2




Figure 38 Thesis work 2.3

diligence, hard work, endurance, bravery, fearlessness, stubbornness, clumsiness, etc. It means wealth, wealth and good luck.




Figure 39 Sketch 1
